The Daan Utsav Samman, which is in its third year, has made individuals, puja committees and NGOs, in addition to schools and housing societies, part of the "Giving" initiative. Fourteen of the Samman 2018 winners were felicitated at Rotary Sadan for their exemplary work. Six schools, two puja committees, two housing societies, two NGOs and two individuals received the third Daan Utsav Samman. While Delhi Public School Megacity got the Daan Utsav Sarvottam Saarvik Samman, the Uttam Saarvik Samman went to Lakshmipat Singhania Academy. South Point School was awarded the Kalyan Samman and Sri Sri Academy, the Arogya Samman.

Sri Sri Academy received the Arogya Samman Award at Daan Utsav 2018 for their meaningful gift to the economically disadvantaged community residing near the school. The students and teachers



wanted to gift the residents health. They realised that communicating the need for hygiene and the role cleanliness plays in maintaining the health of families and their neighbourhood would have a more lasting impact on the community. Therefore, mosquito nets, tubes of mosquito repellent cream, bottles of disinfectant, slippers, toothbrush and toothpaste, towels, soaps, handwash, among other items, were handed out along with talks on how to prevent dengue and malaria.
