School Summer Internship by FORTIS Hospital

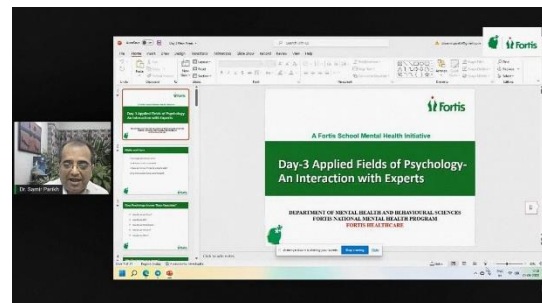
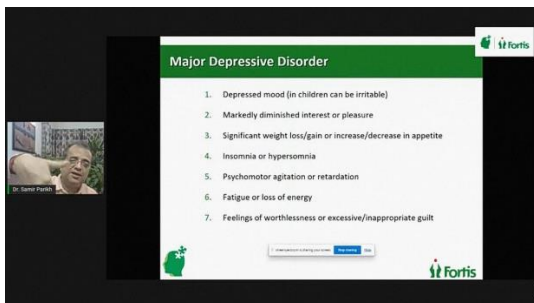
